Dear Residents and Family/Friends,

It is great news that BC continues to do well in our fight against COVID. **Huge thank you's** to EVERYONE for doing your part to keep Seton Villa safe. We have done exceptionally well, and I am eternally grateful for this.

Dr. Bonnie Henry recently announced good news that affects Seton Villa. We have since been directed by Fraser Health to implement the following as of **Monday, July 19<sup>th</sup>**.

1. Visitors are no longer required to schedule visits in advance (no appointments needed)
2. Visitors still need to have the health screen questionnaire and temperature check done when you arrive and use the hand sanitizer frequently
3. Visitors need to sign in, for contact tracing
4. Visitors need to continue to wear a medical mask in all common areas (hallways, elevators)
5. Visitors who have proof of 2 vaccines and are 14 days post vaccination can remove masks in resident's room
6. Non vaccinated visitors must wear mask at all times, including resident's room
7. There is no limit on the number of visitors

**Family and friends, our front desk staff are still REQUIRED to conduct the health screen. With the number of visitors now open, this may mean a wait for you. Please be patient and be prepared this may take some time to get through. Please wait outside. Consider visiting outside of the 20-minute-high traffic times for meals: 11:40 and 12:40 lunch, 4:40 and 5:40 for dinner.**

**Visitors entering Seton Villa:** 7:15 am – 6:45 pm.

Visitors who stay later than 7:00 pm must exit using the west door, down the hallway behind the west lounge on the main floor code: 3755

Family and friends, we welcome you back! Thank you for everyone's patience and compassion as we work to ensure we are following the requirements, staying safe and enjoying time together.

Residents are no longer required to wear masks in common areas, although highly recommended.

On another note, for those of you who may not know, Sandra Glover retired as of July 9<sup>th</sup>. We miss her already but wish her and her husband a very happy retirement in their new home in Blaine, Washington. Recruitment for this position is underway.
